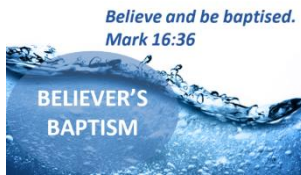

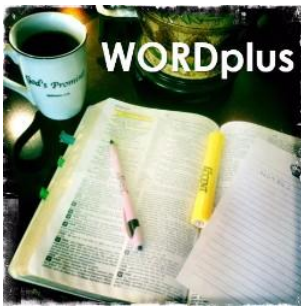

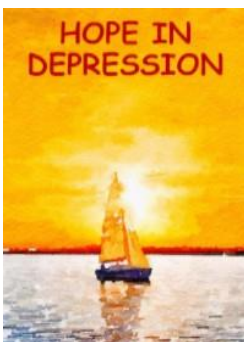


Good to Go. Saturday 14th October. 9:30am - 3.30pm.
